Information for new members

The South Australian Community Transport Association (Sacta) was incorporated on the 4th September, 2013; our aim is to establish Sacta as the peak body representing community transport in South Australia and the Northern Territory.

The objects of the Association are:

1. To represent community transport providers within South Australia and the Northern Territory and to advocate and/or make representations on behalf of its members to the Government Sector, Non- Government Sector, Private Sector and all other relevant organisations and/or persons.
2. To facilitate information sharing and improve communication between community transport organisations and services within South Australia and the Northern Territory.
3. To develop policy, procedure and standards that promote best practice in community transport.
4. To represent its membership on the board of ACTA (Australian Community Transport Association) and/or international forums related to these objects.

In order to achieve our objectives we need your support; please help us by distributing this information to all of your networks, and also by becoming a member of Sacta.

Your joining fee and membership fees will go towards maintaining our website, regular state-based conferences and information forums, and as members you will be invited to attend our Annual General Meeting, an opportunity for networking and information sharing as well as a chance to discuss and influence future directions for Sacta and Community Transport in South Australia.

Sacta offers two options for membership:

- Membership of the Association is open to Community Transport (CT) providers in South Australia and the Northern Territory.
- Associate membership is available to individuals and organisations who are not community transport providers, but who are interested and concerned with issues of community and accessible transport (no voting rights).

Membership fee structure:

- *Once off joining fee:* \$50
- *Annual membership fee:* \$150 (due 1st July each year)
- *Annual Associate membership:* \$100 (due 1st July each year)
